

## RESOLUTION

### GRANT AWARD - COMMONWEALTH ATTORNEY -

### VICTIM'S WITNESS GRANT PROGRAM - \$183,260

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Attorney for the City of Williamsburg and James City County has been awarded a \$183,260 federal grant from the Victim's Witness Grant Fund (federal share \$137,445; state share \$45,815) through the State Department of Criminal Justice Services; and

WHEREAS, this grant would fund the personnel costs for the continuation of three full-time equivalent positions; and one part-time position; and

WHEREAS, these positions provide comprehensive information and direct services to crime victims and witnesses beginning July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.


