

RESOLUTION

APPROPRIATION - HURRICANE MICHAEL - \$93,824

WHEREAS, in October 2018, Hurricane Michael hit James City County producing a tornado that downed trees and limbs; and

WHEREAS, emergency protective measures were taken to protect public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, debris removal and pickup was completed throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, James City County has filed claims to request public assistance for disaster recovery from the Federal Emergency Management Agency for costs totaling \$93,824; and

WHEREAS, these claims are cost-shared by the federal government at 75%, state government at 15%, and local share at 10%.


