DECLARATION OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

The County Administrator of James City County who serves as the Director of Emergency Management pursuant to section 44-146.19 of the *Code of Virginia*, 1950, as amended (the "Virginia Code") and as designated in the James City County Emergency Operations Plan adopted by the Board of Supervisors on December 10, 2019, has declared a local emergency pursuant to Virginia Code section 44-146.21 at ________ on August 3, 2020. The Board of Supervisors will be advised as soon as practicable.

This declaration is due to the damage and destruction that is expected to occur in James City County between August 3 and 4 due to wind, rain, flooding, tree falls, and power outages from tropical storm Isaias, creating conditions of extreme peril to the lives, safety, and property of the residents of James City County. The proclamation of the existence of an emergency is necessary to permit the full powers of the government to deal effectively with this condition of peril.

The Director of Emergency Management will request that the Board of Supervisors adopt a Resolution confirming this Declaration at its next regularly-scheduled meeting on September 8, 2020.
