

RESOLUTION

GRANT AWARD - COMMONWEALTH ATTORNEY -

VICTIM'S WITNESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM - \$183,260

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Attorney for the City of Williamsburg and James City County has been awarded a \$183,260 grant from the Victim's Witness Grant Fund (federal share \$128,282; state share \$54,978) through the State Department of Criminal Justice Services; and

WHEREAS, this grant would fund the personnel costs for the continuation of three full-time equivalent positions; and

WHEREAS, these positions provide comprehensive information and direct services to crime victims and witnesses beginning July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, no local match is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of James City County, Virginia, hereby authorizes the additional appropriation to the Special Projects/Grants Fund for purposes described above.
