SUBJECT:	Long Range Public Transportation Plan

James City County Transit (JCCT) was formed in 1976 with the purpose of providing public transportation to meet the human services needs of our citizens. JCCT has performed this function well for the past 25 years, but we began several years ago, with the implementation of the Visitors Shuttle, to evaluate the feasibility of broadening JCCT's mission and transforming it into a more regional public transportation system.

The Long Range Public Transportation Plan includes recommendations on how to transform JCCT into a more regional public transportation system. This entails making public transportation more attractive to a greater number of citizens, students, and visitors. We believe we can do this while still maintaining, and in fact improving, the level of service to those who need public transportation the most.

The Long Range Public Transportation Plan was funded through a grant from Crossroads. A steering committee, consisting of representatives of the County, the City of Williamsburg, York County, the College of William and Mary, Colonial Williamsburg, Chamber of Commerce, the Convention and Visitors Bureau, the National Park Service, and the Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation, guided the work of the consultant.

Attached is a copy of the Long Range Public Transportation Plan for your review and informational purposes. Staff will not be asking you to make any decisions at the Work Session regarding this information.
