

- Formal regional process follows




### Methodology


- Designed to be open and participatory
- Divided into two phases:
  - 1. Gathering information and public input
  - 2. Developing policy
- Creates the Community Participation Team (CPT) and Steering Committee (SC) to work on each of two phases
- Involves County staff and boards




