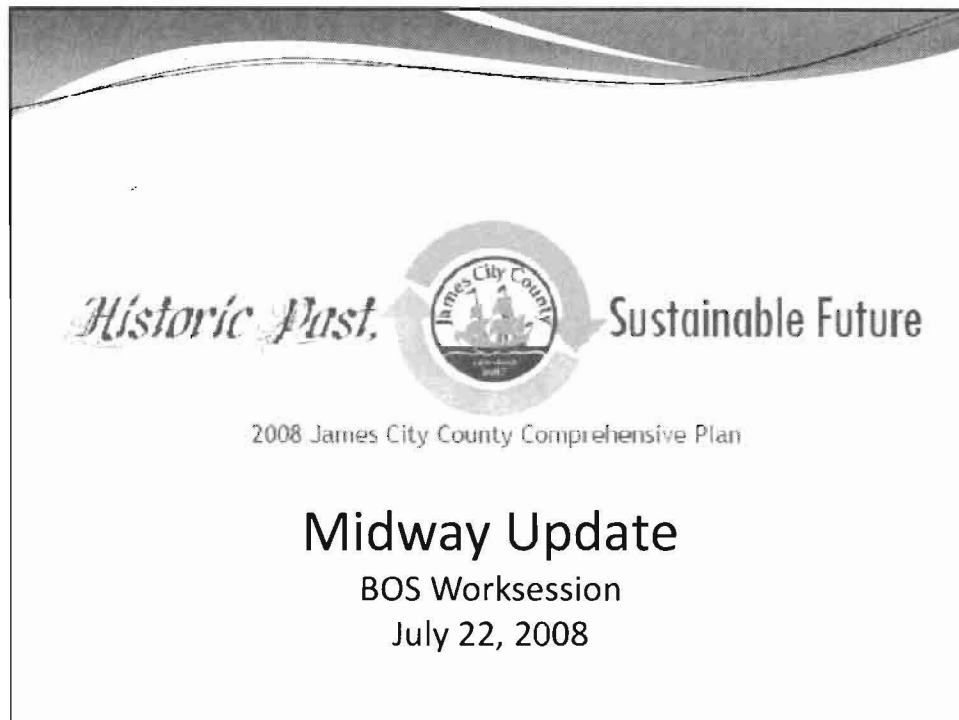

- Based upon award-winning process (VML, VAPA, NACo)
- Enhanced with new elements
- Formal regional process follows



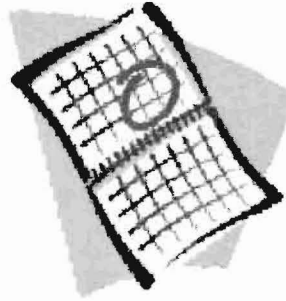

## Methodology

- Designed to be open and participatory
- Divided into two phases:
  1. *Gathering information and public input*
  2. *Developing policy*
- Creates the Community Participation Team (CPT) and Steering Committee (SC) to work on each of two phases
- Involves County staff and boards

## Timeline

- 22-month process
- 1<sup>st</sup> Phase (CPT)
  - *Near completion*
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase (SC)
  - *Getting underway soon*
- PC Consideration – June 2009


- Impacts of Growth

  - Regional cooperation





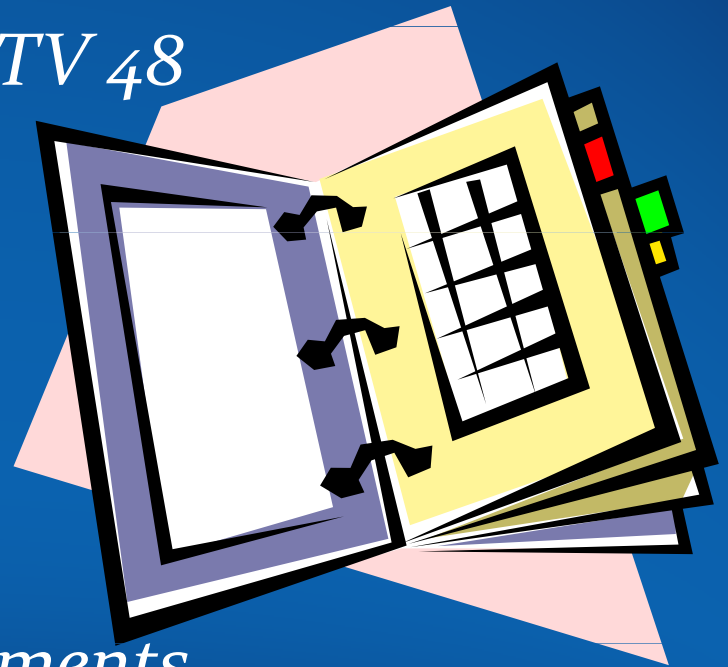
