- WHEREAS, the proposed budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003, did not contain sufficient funds for the Water Storage Tank Maintenance contract; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Directors adopted said budget on May 14, 2002; and
