DATE: July 22, 2014 TO: The Board of Directors FROM: M. Douglas Powell, General Manager, James City Service Authority SUBJECT: Dam Safety Grant Awards - Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation - \$1,700 and \$9,500

The James City Service Authority (JCSA) has been awarded two Dam Safety Grants by the Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR), Dam Safety and Floodplain Management Division in the amounts of \$1,700 and \$9,500. The funding source is the Virginia Dam Safety, Floodplain Prevention and Protection Assistance Fund.

The JCSA owns the earthen dam located along Point O'Woods Road in the Mirror Lakes neighborhood. The \$1,700 grant reimburses the JCSA for 16 percent of the cost of an Alternatives Analysis engineering study. The study evaluated three alternatives for renovations needed to meet the Commonwealth's Impounding Structure Regulations and included a cost summary for each alternative. The \$9,500 grant reimburses the JCSA for 16 percent of the cost of Renovation Engineering Services to design the selected alternative of adding additional pipes as a secondary spillway. Timmons Engineering performed the Alternatives Analysis study and designed the secondary spillway.

The grants each require a 50 percent match. The matching funds for these reimbursement grants were provided in the JCSA's Capital Improvements Program (CIP) budget.

Staff recommends adoption of the attached resolution.
