SUBJECT: Easement Abandonment - 124 Cooley Road - Indigo Park

Mr. Ed Carr has requested on behalf of Gilbert Demari, owner of 124 Cooley Road in Indigo Park, that the James City Service Authority (JCSA) abandon 3,702.6 square feet or 0.085 acres of an existing 25-foot-wide JCSA easement on the eastern side of the property along Travis Lane. The portion of the easement being requested for abandonment is no longer required by either 122 Cooley Road or 124 Cooley Road for water or sewer services. The services will be connected to the water and sewer along Cooley Road.

The sewer main is located within an older recorded 10-foot-wide easement to serve lots on Travis Lane. JCSA only requires an additional five feet from 124 Cooley Road for access to the sewer main. The sewer main will continue to be located within a privately owned right-of-way with JCSA retaining full access for maintenance.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the attached resolution authorizing the General Manager to sign the necessary documents to quitclaim the easement as requested and depicted on the attached plat prepared by Angle & Distance Land Surveying, Inc. entitled "JCSA Sewer Easement Modification Plat Of The Properties Standing In The Name Of Gilbert J. Demari" and dated August 1, 2016.


