SUBJECT: General Manager's Authorization to Convey James City Service Authority's Easement

Interests in Property Equal to or Less Than One-Half Acre

The James City Service Authority ("JCSA") often acquires easement rights to access real property owned by other parties for the purpose of installing, maintaining, and operating water and sewer facilities. Sometimes these easement rights become unnecessary for the function of JCSA's water and sewer facilities as needs change, facilities become rerouted, or other circumstances change. When this happens, it might be in the best interest of JCSA to convey its easement interest back to the owner of the property.

Most of the easement interests held by JCSA that become unnecessary involve real property that measure less than one-quarter acre in area. Currently, the General Manager is required to present the Board of Directors with a resolution authorizing the General Manager to convey such easement interest each time one of these small, relatively inexpensive easement interests become unnecessary. The resolution presented here would remove such requirement where the size of the property over which the easement interest runs is less than one-half acre in area and when the General Manager has determined in his professional judgment that the easement interest is no longer necessary for the function of the JCSA's water and sewer facilities. This would allow such conveyances to occur more expeditiously.

Staff recommends the Board of Directors adopt the resolution authorizing the General Manager to convey JCSA's unnecessary easement interests in property where the area of the property interest is equal to or less than one-half acre when the General Manager determines that such easement right is no longer necessary to the function of JCSA's water and sewer facilities.

RESOLUTION

GENERAL MANAGER'S AUTHORIZATION TO CONVEY JAMES CITY

SERVICE AUTHORITY'S EASEMENT INTERESTS IN PROPERTY EQUAL TO OR

LESS THAN ONE-HALF ACRE

- WHEREAS, the James City Service Authority ("JCSA") acquires easement rights across real property owned by other parties for the public purposes of installing, maintaining, and operating JCSA's water and sewer facilities; and
- WHEREAS, JCSA's possession of some easement rights may eventually become unnecessary to the function of JCSA's water and sewer facilities; and
- WHEREAS, many of these easement rights pertain to small areas of real property that are less than one-half acre; and
- WHEREAS, allowing the General Manager to convey interests in unnecessary easements across small properties is expeditious, promotes flexibility, and protects the interest of the JCSA; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Directors, following a public hearing, is of the opinion that the General Manager should have the authority to convey JCSA's easement interests in areas of property that are equal to or less than one-half acre when the General Manager determines that the JCSA's possession of such easement right is no longer necessary to the function of JCSA's water and sewer facilities.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the James City Service Authority, James City County, Virginia, does hereby authorize the General Manager to convey JCSA's unnecessary easement interests in property where the area of the property interest is equal to or less than one-half acre when the General Manager determines that such easement right is no longer necessary to the function of JCSA's water and sewer facilities.
