

Discussion followed with general endorsement that the Pre-School Task Force would further study the combination of services for cost effectiveness.

Discussion of Mr. Edwards' draft proposal of long range planning of construction of a third high school followed with general consensus that the School Liaison Committee would work on developing a proposed agreement regarding a future high school project.
