B. WORK SESSIONS

Mr. Edwards called the meeting to order.

1. Water Conservation

Mr. Larry Foster, General Manager, James City Service Authority (JCSA), welcomed the Water Conservation Task Force, which had developed recommendations to encourage water efficiency: adjust tiers to create a greater distinction in costs of water for lower and higher use tiers; amend the County's landscape ordinance to reflect water conserving landscaping techniques, design and plant choices; enact an ordinance that requires certification of installers and designers of irrigation systems; disseminate educational material to homeowners to inform County residents of water-wise landscaping methods, drought tolerant plants and current technology; establish water efficient community certification; and establish demonstration plots throughout the County at all new buildings, existing JCSA/JCC sites, etc.

Discussion by the Board, staff and Task Force followed.

2. Property Information System


Mr. Richard Sebastian, Director of Real Estate Assessments, gave a demonstration on the James City County property information and GIS maps and how to access that information currently available on the Internet. He stated that the information and maps serve both the public and James City County staff by providing current real estate assessment data that included ownership assessments, sales, and other information on all James City County properties.
