

FIREWORKS

"WHEREAS, at the regular December, 1947, meeting of this Board, there was proposed an ordinance making it unlawful to sell, buy or fire fireworks in the County of James City with the penalty proposed of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00 for each offense, and

"WHEREAS, notice of the proposal of the said ordinance has been duly published as required by law and the proposed ordinance having been unanimously adopted;

"THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of James City County that it shall be unlawful for any person to buy, sell or fire fireworks within James City County, and each offense shall carry a penalty of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00; this ordinance shall become effective from the date of its passage."

Adopted January 5, 1948--see Volume 5, page 57. It did not appear that this ordinance had been properly advertised, so it was readvertised and adopted December 6, 1954--see Volume 5, page 270. Publication of this ordinance did not comply with the law and the ordinance was readvertised and enacted September 6, 1955--see Volume 5, page 304.
