

PEEPING OR SPYING INTO A STRUCTURE OCCUPIED AS A DWELLING

Adopted January 9, 1961--Volume 6, page 118.

"If any person shall unlawfully enter upon the property of another, in the night time, and secretly or furtively peep through or attempt to so peep, into, through, or spy through, a window, door or other aperture of any building, structure, or other enclosure of any nature occupied or intended for occupancy as a dwelling, whether or not such building, structure or enclosure be permanently situated or transportable and when or not such occupancy be permanent or temporary, such person shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be fined not more than \$100.00 nor less than \$10.00, and in addition may be confined in jail for a period not to exceed thirty days."
