

PROFANE SWEARING AND DRUNKNESS

Adopted January 9, 1961--see Volume 6, page 118.

"If any person arrived at the age of discretion profanely curse or swear, or get or be drunk in public, he shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than \$1.00 or more than \$10.00.

"If any person shall be convicted for being drunk in public three times within one year in this County, upon the third or any subsequent conviction for such offense within the period of one year, such person may be punished by imprisonment in jail for not more than six months or by a fine of not more than \$25.00 or by both fine and imprisonment."

RIOTOUS OR DISORDERLY CONDUCT IN PUBLIC PLACES

Adopted January 9, 1961--see Volume 6, page 119.

"If any person behaves in a riotous or disorderly manner in any street, highway, public building or any other public place, or causes any unnecessary disturbance in or on any public conveyance, by running through it, climbing through windows or upon the seats, failing to move to another seat when lawfully requested to so move by the operator, or otherwise annoying passengers or employees therein, he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor."
