AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND REORDAIN CHAPTER 18. TAXATION, OF THE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF JAMES CITY, VIRGINIA, BY AMENDING ARTICLE V, SPECIAL TAX FOR ENHANCED 911 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM, SECTION 18-25, TAX IMPOSED.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of James City, Virginia, that Chapter 18, Taxation, is hereby amended and reordained by amending Section 18-25, Tax imposed.


Chapter 18. Taxation

Article V. Special Tax for Enhanced 911 Emergency Telephone System

Section 18-25. Tax imposed.


Pursuant to the provisions of Section 58.1-3813 of the Code of Virginia, there is hereby imposed a special tax of ~~\$0.30~~ \$1.20 per month on each consumer of telephone service for each telephone line provided by any corporation subject to the provisions of chapter 26 of title 58.1 of the Code of Virginia; provided, however, that this tax is not imposed on federal, state or local government agencies. *The definitions provided in article 4, chapter 38 of title 58.1 shall apply to this article.*

This ordinance shall become effective July 1, 1997.
