AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND REORDAIN CHAPTER 18, TAXATION, OF THE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF JAMES CITY, VIRGINIA, BY AMENDING ARTICLE IV, TRANSIENT LODGING TAX, SECTION 18-14, TAX LEVIED.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of James City, Virginia, that Chapter 18, Taxation, is hereby amended and reordained by amending Section 18-14, Tax levied.

Chapter 18 Taxation


Article IV. Transient Lodging Tax

Section 18-14. Tax levied.

There is hereby levied and imposed, in addition to all other taxes and fees of every kind now imposed by laws, on each transient a tax equivalent to ~~two (2)~~ *four* percent of the total amount paid for lodging by or for any such transient to any hotel. Such tax shall be collected from such transient at the time and in the manner provided by this article.


