AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND REORDAIN CHAPTER 1, GENERAL PROVISIONS, OF THE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF JAMES CITY, VIRGINIA, BY DELETING SECTION 1-12, DISPOSAL OF UNCLAIMED PROPERTY, GENERALLY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of James City, Virginia, that Chapter 1, General Provisions is hereby amended and reordained by deleting Section 1-12, Disposal of unclaimed property.

Chapter 1. General Provisions


~~Sec. 1-12. Disposal of unclaimed property. Reserved.~~

~~Any unclaimed personal property which has been in possession of the police department and unclaimed for a period of sixty (60) days may be disposed of at public sale in accordance with the requirements of Section 15.2-1719 of the Code of Virginia. Unclaimed personal property shall be any personal property belonging to another which has been acquired by a law enforcement officer pursuant to his duties, which is not needed in any criminal prosecution, which has not been claimed by its rightful owner, and which the state treasurer has indicated will be declined if remitted under the Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property Act.~~
