1. Minutes from the August 8, 2018, regular meeting

The minutes from the August 8, 2018, regular meeting were approved as written.

Mr. Hughes made the motion to accept the minutes.

D. PUBLIC HEARINGS

1. WJPA 18-0070 : William & Mary Sailing Team

The College of William & Mary Sailing Team has applied for a wetlands permit for installation of a floating dock on property located at 1010 Kingsmill Road, within the Kingsmill Marina of the Kingsmill Resort subdivision and the James River watershed. The property is further

identified as James City County Tax Map Parcel No. 5040100002C. Staff described the current site conditions of the proposed project and recommended approval of the permit with conditions.

The Board deliberated the pros and cons of this permit.

Mr. Hughes opened the Public Hearing.

A. Ms. Audrey Fulk, President of The of College William & Mary Sailing Team, addressed the Board and answered further questions.

Mr. Hughes closed the Public Hearing, as no one else wished to speak.

Mr. Apperson made a motion to grant the permit for Wetlands Board Case No. WJPA-18-0070/VMRC 17-0133 at 1010 Kingsmill Road, Kingsmill Marina.

E. BOARD CONSIDERATIONS

1. W-04-16 / VMRC 15-1211 : Colonial Pipeline

Staff presented the extension request of the permit obtained by Corblu Ecology Group, LLC on behalf of the Colonial Pipeline Company. The permit was originally issued on November 12, 2015, for a period of three years. The permit is for the ongoing preventative maintenance of the pipeline as regulated by the United States Department of Transportation (DOT) at the following parcels: James River Parcel ID No. 5940100003; Halfway Creek Parcel ID No. 4920100006; College Creek Parcels ID No. 4910230001A and ID No. 49103A0002A; Powhatan Creek Parcel ID No. 4610100008 and the Chickahominy River Parcel ID No. 3430100002. Mr. Woolson explained Corblue is asking for a three year extension until December 31, 2021. Condition No. 5 of the original wetlands permit states that the permit may be extended out until December 31, 2025, upon the Wetlands Board discretion. Staff is agreeable with either extension date with the stipulation that all previous Conditions No. 4(1)-4(3) be continued and that Condition No. 4(4) have a new expiration date of either December 31, 2021, or December 31, 2025, depending upon the Board's direction. Mr. Woolson explained that if the Board extended the permit to December 31, 2025, that the permit would run concurrent with the VMRC permit for the same project.

Mr. Gussman made a motion to grant the extension of the permit until December 31, 2025, for Wetlands Board Case No. W-04-16/VMRC 15-1211.
