2. MINUTES

Upon a motion by Mr. Kirtland, seconded by Ms. Ware, the minutes of the March 9, 1983 meeting were approved as presented.

3. CASE NO. W-1-83. MS. CHARLOTTE P. MANGUM

Mr. Murphy presented the staff report. He noted that on the bottom paragraph on page one, change "mean low water" to "a distance of 25 feet." This resulted from an inspection made by VIMS the morning of April 27, 1983 which revealed beach characteristics that had not been noted on previous inspections. The expiration date on the second page of the report had to be changed to October 31, 1983.

Mr. Priest from VIMS informed the Board that the wetlands site had been re-evaluated that morning. He stated that artificially filling with sand should be at the property owner's option because of the condition of the bank. He further advised the Board that the purpose of a spur would be to protect the groin and the artificial fill would help protect the property of downdrift neighbors.


Ms. Carey closed the public hearing.
