**B. MINUTES**

**D. NEW BUSINESS**

Case No. W-7-90. G. R. Regan

Mr. Farmer stated that Wilbur Jordan, the contractor, has applied on behalf of G. R. Regan, the owner, for a wetlands permit for the construction of approximately 100 linear feet of tongue and groove bulkheading at 107 Godspeed Lane in the Powhatan Shores Subdivision. He stated that the wetlands involved on the property consist of approximately 200 square feet of freshwater mixed vegetation. The contractor proposes to construct the bulkhead by tying into the existing bulkheads on adjacent properties and encroaching one to two feet channelward on mean high water. The staff recommendation was for approval of 100 linear feet of tongue and groove bulkheading subject to the following conditions:

1. The proposed bulkhead tie into the adjacent bulkheads and follow the curvature of the shoreline at mean high water. This alignment must be staked by the Code Compliance Office prior to construction.

2. The contractor obtain a building permit prior to construction.

3. The contractor shall contact the Code Compliance for an inspection of the filter cloth and tiebacks prior to backfilling.

4. The permit shall expire on June 13, 1991.

Mr. Lindsey opened the public hearing.

There being no public discussion, Mr. Lindsey closed the public hearing.


The vote for approval of the permit was unanimous.
